Announcement on the extension of abstract submission

Due to COVID-19 epidemic, all the spring academic societies have been cancelled or held on web. We understand that there are some members who are concerned about the schedule of this academic meeting in November but we are currently working hard to prepare for the 50th Annual Meeting, which will be held from November 26th (Thu) to 28th (Sat) this year as originally scheduled.

Recently a meeting between the president and the executive board was held and the following were discussed:

- 1) No postponement or alteration for the Annual Meeting date.
- 2) There will be live distribution of the lectures, symposiums, and presentations that are being held at each venue for those who cannot participate on site. Members who have paid the fees in advance will be provided access to watch the lectures via web.
- 3) If most members cannot come to Kyoto, we are considering web presentations from their homes or potentially only the presenters come to the venue to present their lectures through live stream.
- 4) Participation scores will be given regardless of the format.

Currently, we are planning to hold a conference on site at the Kyoto International Conference Center as originally planned, and we are making sure that it can be held on the same schedule no matter how the situation changes.

We have extended the call for general abstracts for about one month until July 15<sup>th</sup> (Wed). Although it is a difficult time, we are hoping that many members will be able to join us to feel the best season in Kyoto.
