Due to the influence of this COVID-19 and in consideration of the future situation of the world, the 19th International Symposium on Epstein-Barr Virus and associated diseases, which was postponed to July 26th to 30th, 2021, will now be held on July 29th (Thu) and 30th (Fri), 2021. Live streaming will take place on these 2 days, along with On-demand online streaming of presentations for about 2 weeks from August 2nd (Mon) to 15th (Sun), 2021. We considered difficult for all the participants to come directly to Asahikawa from overseas if the event was held as usual, hence we decided to bring this style of Symposium. Live streaming on the 29th (Thu) and 30th (Fri) is basically based on face-to-face live attendance, however, online participation from a remote location is also possible.
